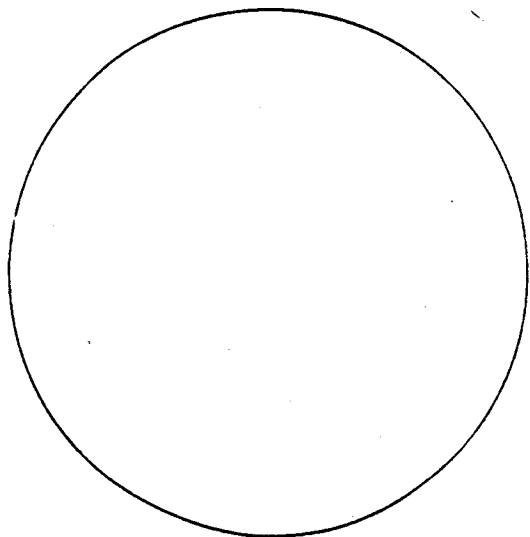
Picnic Button Contest

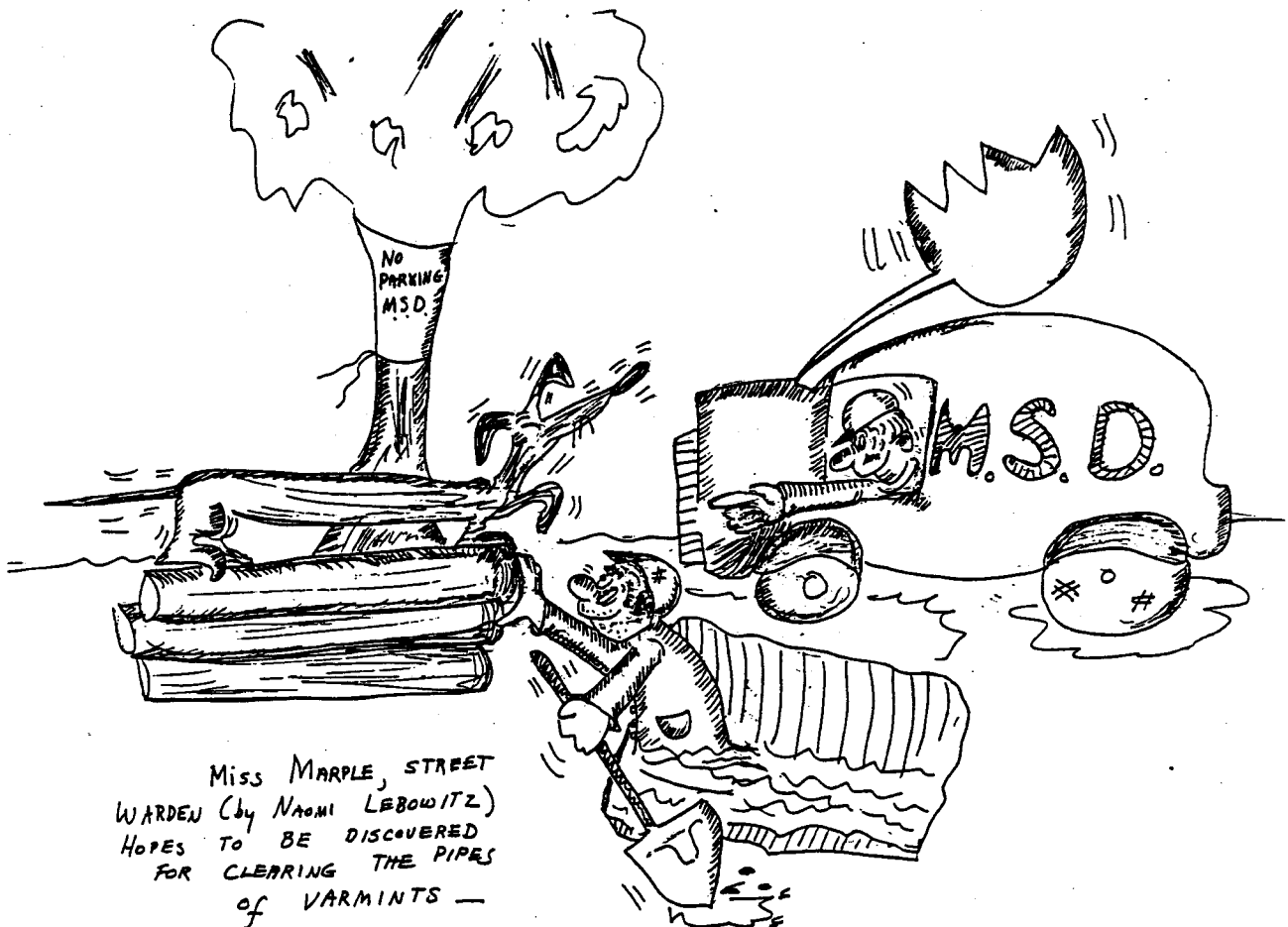
